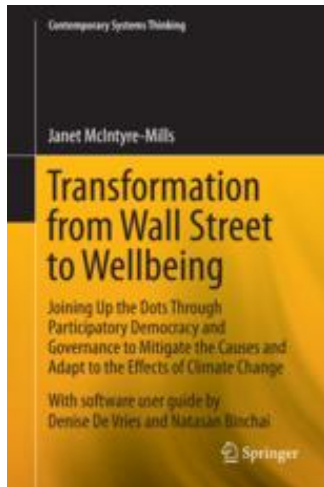

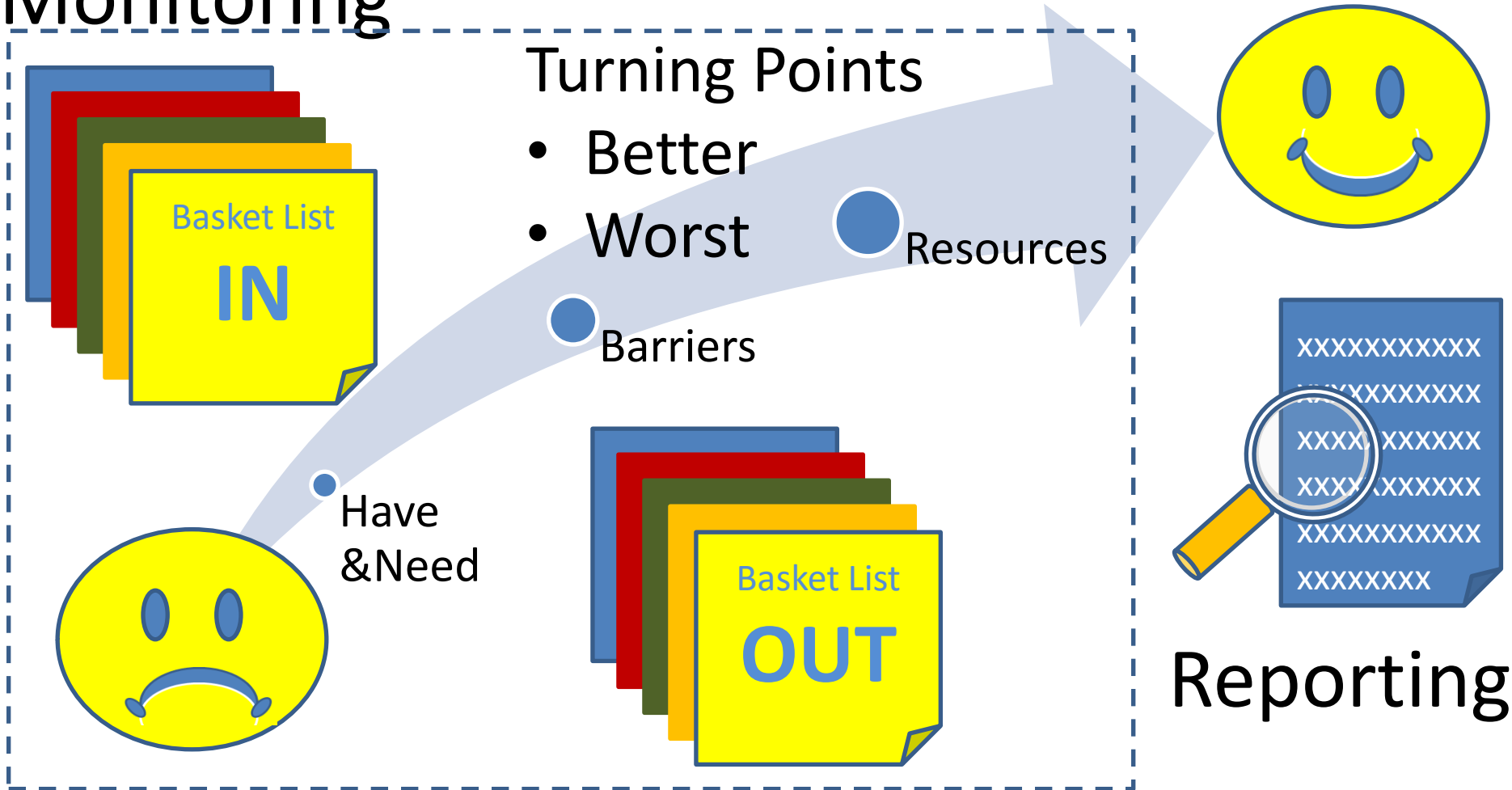
Pathways To Wellbeing Concept

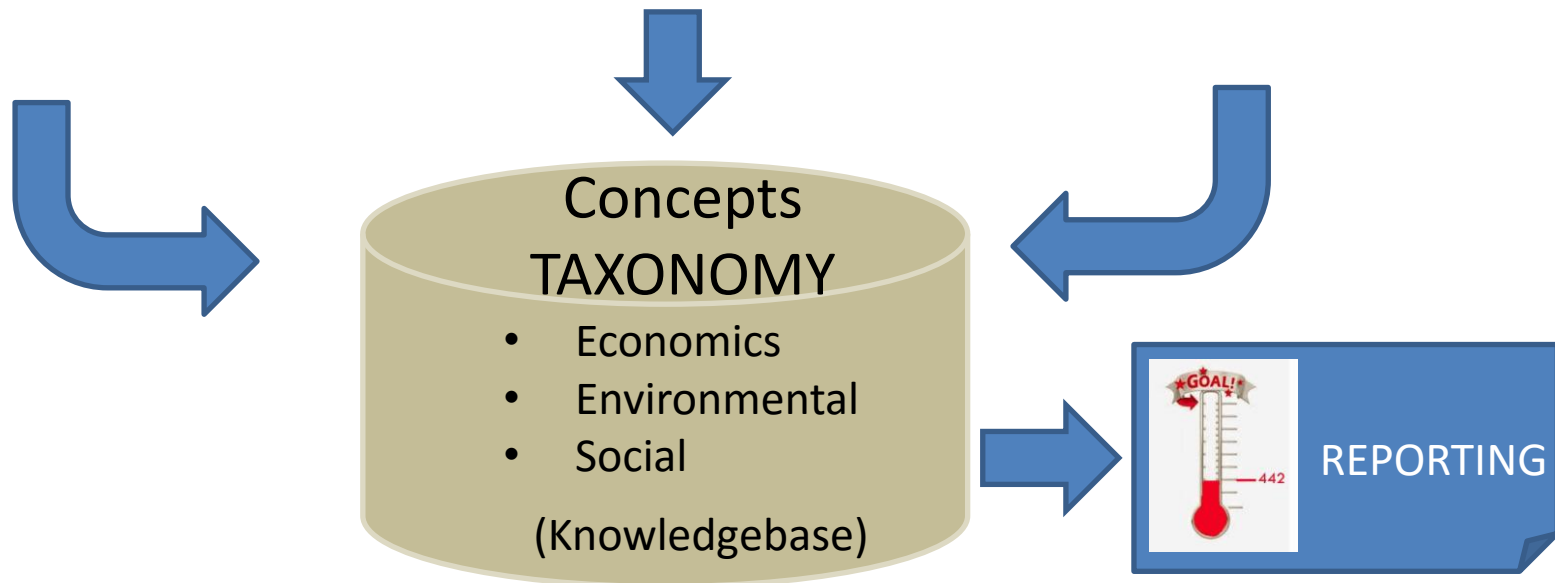

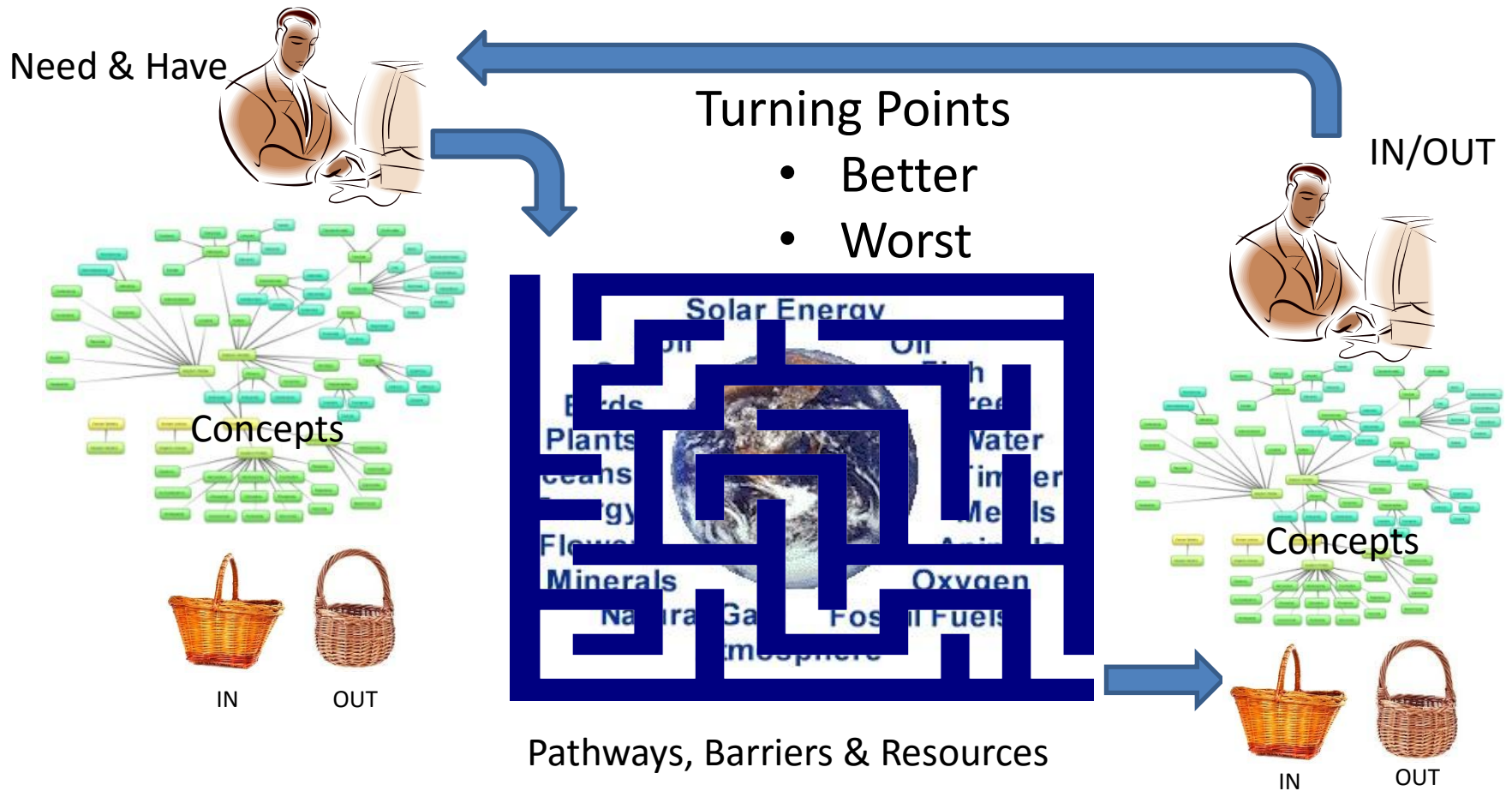

Iterative Process Pathways To Wellbeing




Taxonomy Concept Overview
